ENTRIES:

All entry fees must be prepaid. Entries MAY be closed with a notice on Facebook if/when capacity is reached.

April 10, 2026 is the earlybird deadline for Junior and 4-H Division Shows to register to receive one crewneck.

Exhibitors receive one crewneck only, whether they enter the Mighty Mite, Junior Show and/or 4-H Show.

Cattle entered in the 4-H Division Show must not cross-enter into any of the other shows. However, the exhibitor can use a 4-H Division Show registered animal for the Junior Showmanship.

Cross-entries are permitted between the Junior and the Open Show (exhibitor age permitting - over 21 aren't allowed in the Junior Show).

Animals are to be owned by the youth showing them.

Cattle entered in the 4-H Division Show must be registered in the 4-H program, the exhibitor must also be a currently registered 4-H Canada member showing their own project.

The 4-H steer or 4-H heifer entered must be shown by the 4-H member that owns the project.

No substitutions on the 4-H halter.

NEW in 2026 - OPEN CHAMPIONS - GRAND AND RESERVE will be eligible for the Junior Show.

Liability forms (part of entry form) must be signed and submitted. Everyone enters at their own risk.

Photo/Video release (part of entry form) must be signed and submitted. This event is live-streamed.

Entry fees **WILL NOT** be refunded due to cancellation by the exhibitor.

Yearling (breeding) heifers and pairs are shown by birthdate in the JUNIOR SHOW.

NEW in 2026 - OPEN SHOW - YEARLING Heifers are shown by Breed Influence. There must be a minimum of four (4) to make a breed, otherwise they will be in the AOB class. Yearling - means born in 2025.

Finished steers are shown by weight in ALL SHOWS.

NO SUBSTITUTIONS AFTER MAY 10, 2026. SCRATCHES ONLY. NO REFUNDS.

CATTLE SAFETY & REQUIREMENTS

All cattle must have visible CCIA tags.

All cattle onsite must be halterbroke. Cattle must be cared for by the owners.

Owners assume ALL responsibility of their animals onsite. NO animals can be left onsite after the show ends on Saturday, May 23, 2026. Animals left will be considered donated to JAS Classic Committee - thank you!

EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS

4-H Division SHOW - Must be a currently registered 4-H (9-21 years of age) member in Canada. Only those 21 years of age and under are able to help fit the animal. Assistance from parents/ guardians is permitted as long as it is for learning purposes.

OPEN SHOW - Any and all ages are able to fit and show the animal.

JUNIOR SHOW - 21 years of age and younger must fit and show the animal. Assistance from parents/ guardians is permitted as long as it is for learning purposes.

MIGHTY MITES - 8 years of age and younger as of May 23, 2026

SHOWMANSHIP - 8 years of age and younger as of May 23, 2026. Junior - 9-11 yr. Intermediate - 12-14 yr. Senior 15-21 yr. **AGES NOTED AS OF SHOW DAY - MAY 23, 2026.**

STALLING & WASH RACKS

NOTE - FORT SASKATCHEWAN 4-H BEEF CLUB SHOW AND SALE WILL BE IN PROGRESS ON FRIDAY, MAY 22, 2026. The SUPPER being served is for the 4-H SHOW and SALE. Not part of the JAS Classic move-in.

> The barn will be open to JAS Classic exhibitors and cattle on Friday, May 22/26 from 3 - 8 pm.

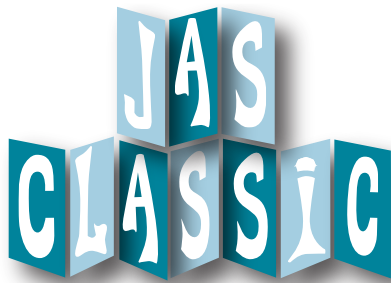
Indoor stalling is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Spots will NOT be arranged by the JAS Classic Committee. Only use space you need. There will be space beside the animals for tack. BRING GENERATORS / EXTENSION CORDS. No generators or inverters allowed inside the building.

PLEASE do not leave tackboxes, etc. outside overnight. Your animals and equipment are your responsibility. JAS is not responsible for your belongings.

NO SHAVINGS or STRAW on the gravel or hardtop outside. Exhibitors will be expected to clean up around their trailers. Throw away all garbage. Please clean up your area.

Indoor overnight stalling IS permitted for livestock only. No overnight access to your animals in the building. Wash racks are located inside and outside the SOUTH WEST overhead door (main cattle door) of the Pointe.

Our new location - THE POINTE AG EVENT CENTRE CONTRACT STATES:

- (a) No clipping, fitting, or grooming of cattle is permitted on arena footing or riding surfaces
 - (b) No shavings, straw, sawdust, or other bedding materials are permitted on arena footing at any time
 - (c) No feeding of livestock is permitted on arena footing
 - (d) The arena surface must remain free of debris, manure, and foreign materials at all times
 - (e) Any contamination of footing may result in additional cleaning or repair charges at the renter's expense
 - (f) Livestock areas must be kept clean and maintained throughout the event
 - (g) All manure and soiled bedding must be disposed of in designated manure bins or disposal areas
- >> **EMPTY AEROSOL SHOW SPRAY CANS - PUT IN DESIGNATED the BLUE 45-GALLON DRUMS.**

PRIZES

The Junior and 4-H Shows have payouts for EVERYONE in every class.

Envelopes will be available to pick up at the prize table throughout the show.

The exhibitor is responsible for picking up their prize money.

If any prizes and cash are not claimed, they WILL NOT be mailed out.

JUNIOR CHAMPIONS - Grand Female and Grand Steer will each receive \$450 plus a trophy buckle. Reserve Female and Reserve Steer will each receive \$350 plus a trophy buckle.

4-H DIVISION CHAMPIONS - Grand Heifer and Grand Steer will receive \$450 each plus a trophy buckle. Reserve Heifer and Reserve Steer will receive \$350 each plus a trophy buckle.

OPEN CHAMPIONS - Grand Heifer and Grand Steer will each receive \$1200 plus a trophy buckle. Reserve Heifer and Reserve Steer will each receive \$800 plus a trophy buckle.

SHOWMANSHIP - Mighty Mite, Junior, Intermediate and Senior - Grand and Reserve will each receive a buckle. Grand and Reserve from each will compete in OVERALL Grand and Reserve will win COOLERS.
